Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government fixes MSP of crops, including paddy on varieties basis;
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken for fixing separate MSP for fine and superfine `varieties of crops including paddy for promoting the cultivation of high quality paddy in the country?

(a) to (c): The minimum Support Prices (MSPs) of agricultural produce, including paddy, are fixed by the Government each year. MSP for two varieties of Paddy, Jowar, Cotton and Soyabean are fixed by the Government.

The MSP is in the nature of a minimum guaranteed price for the farmers offered by the Government for their produce in case the market prices fall below that level. If the market offers higher price than MSP, the farmers are free to sell at that price. Superior grade of rice, always commands a higher market price than the MSP. In addition, superfine varities of rice also have a ready export market.

In order to increase production and productivity of foodgrains, including paddy of all varieties, the Government implements a number of schemes/programmes, which include inter alia, National Food Security Mission (NFSM), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Integrated Cereals Development Programme etc.
