- (b) the details of allocation made and funds released by the NSTFDC during each of the last three years and the current year, Statewise:

- (d) if not, the steps taken or proposed to be taken to increase the budget allocation for NSTFDC?

- (a): National Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC) is a Company granted licence under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956 (a company not for profit). NSTFDC implements various schemes at its level. Government provides funds in the form of equity capital to NSTFDC from time to time based on the requirement projected by the company
- (b): State-wise details of allocation made and funds released by NSTFDC during the financial year 2007-08 to 2009-10 and 2010-11 (as on 31.07.2010) are enclosed at Annex.
- (c)&(d): NSTFDC caters to the requirement of targeted beneficiaries (up to double the poverty line) through schemes formulated by the company. The Company is constantly being encouraged to expand its operations so as to cater to maximum beneficiaries.
