Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM (SHRI SULTAN AHMED)

(a), (b), (c) & (d): A proposal was received in January, 2007 requesting for the establishment of an International Hospitality Institute at Alappuzha. In response, the Ministry of Tourism indicated that 5 acres of land would be needed for the purpose. However, no proposal has been received from the State Government as a follow up.
