(a) to (b): State-wise details of projects sanctioned by the Ministry of Tourism during 10th Plan are at annexure.

Ministry of Tourism, grants central financial assistance to the projects in consultation with the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations subject to availability of funds and inter-se priority and adherence to Scheme Guidelines. The pending proposals, in general are considered for prioritization in the financial year.

Implementation and monitoring of projects is primarily the responsibility of concerned State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, Ministry of Tourism also monitors the progress of implementation through review meetings and site visits from time to time. This matter is also discussed in the Regional Conferences of Tourism Minister.
