(a) to (e): An Expert Committee was constituted by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under the Chairpersonship of Prof. S.P.Thyagarajan, for the purposes of suggesting the Pay Structure, Service conditions, Minimum Qualifications for appointment and eligibility for promotions of Teachers and other academic staff and measures for maintenance of standards in universities and colleges.

Based on the recommendations of the committee, UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010 have been notified by the Commission.
