- (b) the number of permanent and contractual teachers working in these schools;
- (c) whether there is any shortage of the teachers;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken to fill up these vacancies?

- (a) : The UT Administration of Lakshadweep has informed that there are 10 Government senior secondary schools functioning in Lakshadweep.
- (b): 67 permanent and 94 contractual teachers are working in these schools.
- (c) to (e) : Pending the recruitment of regular teachers, contract teachers are appointed in school to ensure that studies are not affected.
