ONLINE ADMISSION OF IIT STUDENTS

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there have been complaints about the unsafe system of online admission of IIT students;
- (b) if so, the nature of drawback in the system;
- (c) whether this has been voiced by IIT faculty members also; and
- (d) if so, the corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d) : There are no on-line admissions in the IIT – Joint Entrance Examination (IIT-JEE). However, in the IIT-JEE 2010, the qualified candidates were given an option to fill their choices on-line for admission to courses. As per information given by the Joint Admission Board (JAB), some candidates had inadvertently frozen their choices on-line without following the instructions correctly. They were, however, allowed to submit their choices in hard copy.
