(a) to (c): As part of the Sub-Mission on Polytechnics under Coordinated Action for skill development, this Ministry provides one time financial assistance of Rs.12.30 crore to State Government or UT Administration for setting up a new polytechnic in an unserved or underserved district in the country. An initial grant Rs.2.00 crore has been released during 2009-10 to the Union Territory of Lakshadweep under this scheme.
