Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Administrative Reforms Commission has recommended to hand over the appointment of aided school teachers to the Public Service Commission and give a central role to the civic bodies in the management of schools;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Administrative Reforms Commission has also recommended to make the recruitment of teachers more transparent and accountable to the local communities;
- (d) if so, the reaction of the aided schools thereon; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Union Government to implement these recommendations?

Answer

(a) to (c): The ARC in its 6th Report titled 'Local Governance - An Inspiring Journey into the Future' has recommended that 'Recruitment for hospitals and schools should be made to an institution/Society, moving away from non-accountable State level recruitment'.

(d) & (e): The above recommendation of the ARC has been accepted by the Government and it has been sent to State Governments for consideration and implementation as the matter of recruitment of teachers comes in the domain of the State Governments.
