(a) to (c): Keeping in view the heavy demand for seats in Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs), 585 more sections with capacity of 40 in each section have been added to the existing KVs for 2010-11 session by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS). Orders have also been issued by KVS to open 80 more new KVs during 2010-11 session, thus adding to the capacity by about 400 more sections.
