- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the other major recommendations made by the said Committee and the action taken thereon?

**Answer**

- (a): Tenure of Vice Chancellors is prescribed under the relevant Acts governing State or Central Universities. There is no such proposal under consideration of the central Government to introduce uniform tenure for Vice Chancellors.
