(a)&(b) On July 12, 2010 Indian Space Research Organisation successfully launched Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV-C15) with CARTOSAT-2B satellite from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) SHAR, Sriharikota.

CARTOSAT-2B is a high resolution advanced remote sensing satellite. The images from this satellite will be useful for village level resource assessment and mapping, detailed urban and infrastructure planning and development.
