(a): The State-wise quantity of wheat, rice and other kharif crops procured by Food Corporation of India and other Government agencies for the Central Pool in the last three years is at Annexure. Sugarcane is not procured by the Government agencies for the Central Pool.

(b): This data is not maintained in the Department, as all farmers are free to sell their produce (wheat & paddy) to FCI/State Agencies at Minimum Support Price and any incentive bonus, declared by the Government.
