Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the various schemes being implemented for the growth of the MSME sector in the country;
- (b) If so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the performance of such schemes during each of the last three years, State-wise including Karnataka;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to give added impetus to such schemes for the overall development of the MSME sector in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISES(SHRI DINSHA PATEL)

(a) to (e): The Central Government undertakes review of various Schemes / Programmes being implemented for the growth of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) sector, from time to time. The schemes have been evaluated by the independent agencies for their continuation from X Plan to XI Plan. Further, the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises also review the policies / programmes in consultation with the stakeholders, through 'National Board for MSME (NBMSME)', periodically. Based on the reviews, necessary modifications have been made in some of the major schemes viz. Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme(PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGS), and Micro Small Enterprises- Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP) etc. The state-wise performance of some major schemes during the last three years is at Annexure I to III. With a view to provided added impetus, the plan allocations of these schemes have been significantly enhanced as under:
