- (a) whether any survey has been conducted for widening and undertaking safety measures in view of high number of road accidents occuring on National Highways; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) The survey and investigation of the National Highways is undertaken prior to widening. The survey and investigations includes soil studies, traffic surveys, hydraulic studies, materials report, design of intersections, road safety measures, alignment studies etc. The Road safety is a continuous process and road safety specific projects such as improvement of junctions, provision of crash barriers, improvement of alignment, provision of parking laybyes etc are identified and sanctioned under Plan schemes. Further, provisions of traffic signs, and road markings which enhance road safety are also sanctioned as part of improvement projects such as widening and strengthening.
