- (a) whether the Government has received several complaints/petitions regarding the poor condition of NH-44 in Assam and other connective Highways;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there are any constraints in the proper maintenance of the said NH;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether any target for the completion of required repair work and maintenance of the said NH has been fixed; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (f) The Union Government as well as the State Government have received complaints/petitions from various quarters regarding the poor condition of NH-44 in Assam. The condition of this NH has deteriorated during the intervening period of re-entrustment from Border Roads Organisation (BRO) to State Public Works Department (PWD). Accordingly, the Union Government has sanctioned 8 works amounting to Rs. 173.00 crore for improvement of this NH which are targeted for completion between March, 2011 and March,2012.
