INTER STATE ROAD PROPOSALS FROM MADHYA PRADESH

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposal from the Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding construction of inter-State and financially economically viable roads and bridges in the said State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (c) the details of the bridges constructed on various highways in Madhya Pradesh during the last three years and the current year, State-wise and National Highway-wise?

Answer

(a) & (b) The State Government of Madhya Pradesh has sent a list of 15 nos. of proposals amounting to Rs. 227.98 Crore for financial year 2010-11 under Inter-State connectivity (ISC) and roads of Economic Importance (EI). Proposals under ISC and EI are considered for sanction subject to availability of funds and inter-se priority of works.

(c) The details of bridges constructed on various National Highways during the last three years and the current year is annexed.
