- (b) if so, the time by which they are likely to be appointed?

(a) and (b) There are six level crossings on Kendposi-Maluka section. One level crossing is already manned and Railway has planned to man two unmanned level crossing gates located at Km. 351/33-35 LC No. RBK-38 and Km. 352/21-23 LC No. RBK-39 by 31.03.2011. Remaining three unmanned level crossings do not qualify for manning as per the manning criteria.
