(a) & (b): Ahmednagar-Beed-Parli-Vaijnath is a new line project being executed under cost sharing on 50:50 basis with State Government of Maharashtra, at an anticipated cost of Rs.512.67 crore. An expenditure of Rs.61.13 crore has been incurred on this project upto 31.03.2010 and an outlay of Rs.50 crore has been provided in Budget 2010-11.

(c): The work will be completed in the coming years as per the availability of resources.
