They also organized technology exhibitions and gave away awards and prizes for the exemplary technological contributions of scientists, technologists and entrepreneurs/innovators.

(c): The aims and objectives of celebrating the National Technology Day are to commemorate technological achievements, to encourage Indian entrepreneurs/innovators through awards and recognitions and to showcase the technologies developed indigenously by public as well as private institutions.

(d): The Ministry of Science and Technology under its constituent Departments promotes Science and Technology in States through various measures, such as providing assistance to State Councils for Science and Technology, undertake activities in different parts of the country at State level for Science and Technology awareness, creation and popularization, entrepreneurship development, establishment of Science and Technology parks, biotech parks, technology business incubators and other targeted Science and Technology based interventions for weaker sections, women, scheduled caste and tribes, etc.
