(a) whether due to limited capacity of railway bridges over Tapti in Surat, the incoming trains from East, West and South are required to halt at the outer and get delayed; and

(b) if so, the steps being taken to solve this problem?

(a) & (b) The railway bridge over Tapti river between Surat and Utran provides for double line working and no trains are required to halt or are getting delayed on these bridges in the normal course. The movement of trains on these bridges is from North and South directions and there is no movement from East and West side.
