- (a) the details of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) Laboratories/Research Centers in the country, location-wise;
- (b) the achievements of each Laboratory and Research Centre during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up more research centers/ laboratories in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Tamil Nadu; and
- (e) the time by which the final decision is likely to be taken in this regard?

- (a): CSIR has 37 constituent laboratories, details of which are at Annexure 1.
- (b): The S&T output of CSIR laboratories in last three years has been as below:

Papers published - 12231

Patents filed - 551 (Indian); 839 (foreign)

Patents granted - 1243 (Indian); 983 (foreign)

(d) & (e): In the remaining period of the XI Five Year Plan, three institutes are proposed to be set up by Ministry of Science & Technology and Earth Sciences. They are National Centre for Molecular Materials in Kerala by Department of Science & Technology (DST), National Institutes of Marine Biotechnology in Tamil Nadu by Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and National Centre for Seismology in Uttar Pradesh by Ministry of Earth Sciences.
