(a)to(c): National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) under the Department of Agriculture and Cooperation (DoAC) is the nodal agency for assisting cooperative development in the country. Government through DoAC has undertaken various measures for promotion and development of cooperative sector in the rural areas of the country, such as, framing of National Policy on Cooperatives, enactment of Multi-State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) Act, 2002, policy initiatives for revitalization of cooperative credit structure, etc. There has not been much significant involvement of cooperative societies in the implementation of various programmes in the agro and rural industries sector under the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises.
