- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the preventive steps taken by the Railways in the matter?

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b): 24 complaints have been received against the booking/parcel clerks of Patna, Hajipur and Darbhanga stations during the last three years (since April 2007).
- (c): To prevent malpractices such as overcharging done by booking/parcel clerks, frequent checks are conducted by Commercial as well as Vigilance departments and the staff wherever found responsible are taken up under Discipline & Appeal Rules.
