- (a): The products exported by export-oriented units under the purview of the Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), comprise heterogeneous items, such as wooden furniture, handicraft items, herbal ayurvedic medicines, silk and muslin, readymade garments, papad, etc. As such, the data of khadi and village industry (KVI) products exported are maintained only in terms of value of products exported and not in quantity. The State and Union Territory-wise details of value of KVI products exported during 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 are given in the Annex.
