COMPUTERISATION AT METTUR RAILWAY STATION

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways are considering to undertake computerisation of all reservation centres across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether many railway stations in Dharmapuri districts in Tamil Nadu are yet to be computerisled, including Mettur railway station;
- (d) if so, whether it is also a fact that no canteen facility is existing at said railway station; and
- (e) if so, the steps taken in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Policy exists for computerization of reservation at stations where manual reservation quota has been provided. Computerised reservation facility has been provided at 2141 locations with 7911 counters.
- (c): Yes, Madam. In Dharmapuri district, 4 stations, namely, Morappur, Bommidi, Boddireddipatty & Dharampuri Junction have been provided with computerized reservation facility while at Mettur Dam Railway Station it is planned. Other stations do not qualify for this facility at present.
- (d) to (e): Scale of catering facilities at station is provided duly considering the quantum of passenger traffic, demand of the passengers and availability of space. Dharampuri railway station is a 'D' category station of South Western Railway wherein Railway has already initiated action for provision of catering facilty through inviting of application for running of a vegetarian refreshment room and a tea-cum-coffee stall for the benefit of passengers.
