- (a) the date on which the construction work of Indore-Dahod and Dhar-Chhota Udaypur railway line was started;
- (b) whether said railway line projects would be completed on priority basis by the Railways keeping in view the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Project;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by which the construction work is likely to be completed?

Answer

(a) to (d): Dahod-Indore (200.97 km) and Chhota Udepur-Dhar (157 km) new line projects were included in the Budget 2007-08. Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation Limited (DMICDC) has requested Ministry of Railway for early completion of these projects for development of Pithampur-Dhar Investment Region and Multi-Model Logistic Park (MMLP). Works is being progressed as per availability of resources. The target date of completion has not yet been fixed.
