**Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC) set up in the country, State-wise and location-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up new campuses/centres/branches of IIMC in various parts of the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof State-wise, including Tamil Nadu; and
- (d) the time by which the new campuses/centres/branches are likely to be set up?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI C. M. JATUA)

(a) : At present IIMC's Headquarters is located at Aruna Asaf Ali Marg, JNU New Campus, New Delhi and its only Branch office is located at Sanchar Marg, Dhenkanal, Orissa.

(b) & (c) : Yes, Sir. The details of proposed new Regional Centres of IIMC are as under:

1. Northern Region - Jammu & Kashmir
2. North-East Region - Mizoram
3. Western Region - Vidarbha Region (Maharashtra)
4. Southern Region - Kerala

(d) : The new Centres are likely to start from the academic session 2011-12, in hired premises.
