(a) 178 complaints have been received by the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights regarding Corporal Punishment, harassment, humiliation and sexual abuse of children in schools during the last three years.

(b) Action has been taken in all the complaints by National Commission for Protection of Child Rights by referring to the State Government or other concerned agency for appropriate action as per law.
