(a) & (b): Under Centrally Sponsored Schemes of the Ministry of Women and Child Development for the welfare of women and children, funds are released to the State Governments on the basis of the pace of expenditure reported. The entitlement is finally worked out in accordance with the schematic norms and unspent / excess balance in a particular year is adjusted in the subsequent financial year. The details of funds released during 2007-08 and 2008-09 are given in the Annual Reports of the Ministry for the years 2008-09 and 2009-10 respectively, which are available in the Library of the Lok Sabha Secretariat. The details for the year 2009-10 and the current year are at annex.
