**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether assistance is being given to the States including Rajasthan regarding drinking water under Rajiv Gandhi National Drinking Water Mission;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the funds provided to the States including Rajasthan under the said scheme during the last three years, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (d) the work done under this scheme as on current year in the States and the reaction of the Government thereto?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (MS. AGATHA SANGMA)

- (a) to (c): Yes Sir. Government of India provides assistance to States for making provision of drinking water in rural habitations under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), which is a part of Bharat Nirman. A statement showing year wise and State-wise release of funds during the last three years is at Annex-I.
- (d): Under Bharat Nirman-Rural drinking water, the number of uncovered and quality-affected habitations left to be covered as on 01-04-2010 and progress as on 30-07-2010 is at Annex-II. All the remaining un-covered and quality-affected habitations are targeted to be covered by the end of Bharat Nirman Phase-II, i.e. 2012.
