- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Different criteria have been prescribed for different schemes in order to allocate funds to District Rural Development Agencies under Rural Development and Poverty Alleviation Programmes being implemented by the Ministry of Rural Development. One of the main criteria for funds allocation is incidence of rural poverty.
- (c) to (e): The criteria for allocation of funds under different schemes is reviewed by the Government from time to time in consultation with the concerned Ministries and States.
