- (a)&(b) State Governments have been asked to identify all eligible beneficiaries for old age pension under Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS).
- (c)&(d) Identification of beneficiaries, sanction and disbursement of pension is done by the respective State Governments. The beneficiaries who have not been covered in the identification process may approach the officials of the concerned department implementing the scheme in the State with their grievance.
