THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT(SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a)to (c): No NGO is registered with Ministry of Urban Development. However, NGOs and educational institution etc. may support the community/ implementing agency in project formulation and preparation of proposals under Community Participation Fund (CPF) under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), but the same are not eligible for accessing Government Funds.

Grants have been sanctioned to the NGOs from the scheme "Research in Urban and Regional Planning in Urban Development" as per following details:
