- (a) whether the candidates belonging to the SC and ST communities who qualify against open seat for promotion cannot be adjusted against vacancies earmarked for the SC/ST quota;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps being taken to give justice to the SC/ST students in this regard?

(a) to (d): The Supreme Court in the matter of R.K. Sabharwal v/s. State of Punjab has held that reserved category candidates who are appointed/promoted in Government jobs on their own merit shall be adjusted against unreserved quota and reservation quota vacancies shall be filled in addition to the above. The Government has been following the principle laid down by the Supreme Court.
