- (a) & (b): Three vendors had submitted their proposals in response to the Request for Proposal (RFP) relating to procurement of Attack Helicopters for the Indian Air Force that had been issued on 23rd May,2008. During technical evaluation, it was found that all the three proposals did not comply with all the requirements stipulated in the RFP. Hence, the RFP was withdrawn on 9th March, 2009.
- (c) A fresh RFP has already been issued on 25th May, 2009.
