- (e) the measures taken to ensure non-repetition of such incidents?

(a) to (e): Delhi Police has reported that eight persons were killed in the National Territory of Delhi due to electrocution during rains in the current year. FIRs have been lodged in this regard and investigations have been initiated to, inter-alia, fix responsibility, grant of compensation and ensure non-repetition of such incidents.
