(a) to (d): Exchange of visits between senior military officials is a common feature in our bilateral defence cooperation with various countries, including USA. The purpose of such visits is to promote goodwill and understanding between the Indian Armed Forces and those of other friendly foreign countries. As part of such exchanges, some senior military officials from the US have visited India in the last few months. During such visits, discussions are held on various issues of mutual interest and concern. No defence agreements have been signed during any such recent visit.
