- (c) whether the Government raised this issue with the British Government; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of British Government thereto and the steps taken in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI S.M. KRISHNA)

(a) to (d) It is a fact that in the past, some terrorist organizations directed against India had presence in foreign countries, including the UK. The issue had been taken up at appropriate level with the Governments of the concerned Countries, which acknowledged India's concerns. Government keeps a constant watch on all developments having a bearing on India's interests and security and takes all necessary measures to protect our interests.
