- (a) whether the State Government of Uttar Pradesh has implemented a scheme 'River Front Development of Garh Mukteshwar Brijghat' in the State;
- (b) if so, the funds allocated by the Union Government for the said purpose; and
- (c) the salient features of the scheme?

(a) to (c) Under Ganga Action Plan Phase-II, a scheme 'Construction of bathing ghat at Brijghat, Garhmukteshwar' was sanctioned by the Central Government and an amount of Rs. 104.83 lakh was released to U.P. Irrigation Department for implementation. The scheme was completed in June, 2009. Under the scheme, a 79 meter long bathing ghat along with one changing room for women has been constructed on the right bank of river Ganga at Brijghat.
