- (a)&(b) The idea of setting up of Indira Gandhi Biodiversity Conservation Centre was accepted `in principle` during the Silver Jubilee Celebrations of the Silent Valley National Park in a public function in Kerala. Accordingly, a proposal to this effect has been received in the Ministry.
- (c) An area of 148 sq. km. around the Silent Valley National Park has already been declared as buffer zone in 2007.
