(a) to (d) While no such information confirming gain in popularity for study of Anthropology in the country is available, Anthropology as an academic discipline is being pursued by students in a number of Indian Universities. According to University Grants Commission (UGC), it has circulated UGC Model Curriculum in Anthropology to 153 universities in the country for implementation, out of which 81 universities have implemented the model curriculum in toto or adopted the same with modifications.
