VACANCIES OF NON-TEACHING EMPLOYEES

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of vacancies of non-teaching employees as against the sanctioned strength in Allahabad University;
- (b) whether the working of the University is adversely affected due to shortage of employees; and
- (c) if so, the time by which recruitment is likely to begin?

(a) to (c) According to the information furnished by the University of Allahabad, against the sanctioned strength of 641 non-teaching positions, in the University, there are 123 vacant posts. The University has clarified that though these vacancies do affect the smooth working of the University, the same is, upto an extent, taken care of by engaging persons on fixed wages and on contract basis. The filling up of vacancies is an ongoing process and, therefore, no definite time-frame can be indicated.
