- (c) whether the Government has sanctioned any new projects under this Mission for the State of Jharkhand;
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the funds allocated for the purpose; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) aims to provide overarching umbrella to the existing National programmes of Health and Family Welfare including RCH-II, Malaria, Blindness, Iodine deficiency, Filariasis, Kala Azar, T.B., Leprosy and Integrated disease Surveillance for the whole country including Jharkhand.
- (b) The statement of funds released to states from 2005-06 to 2009-10 is annexed.
- (c) to (d) The National Programme Coordination Committee (NPCC) has approved annual plan of Rs. 516.95 crore for Jharkhand under NRHM.
