## MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD)

- (a) An epidemic is occurrence in community or region of cases of an illness, specific health related behaviour or other health related events in excess of normal expectancy.
- (b) During the last two years, Pandemic Influenza A H1N1( swine flu) is the only disease that has been declared as a Pandemic [an epidemic occurring over a very wide area affecting a large proportion of population] and spread across the country.
