Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received complaints with regard to the low standards of education and the lack of facilities in some of the private medical colleges in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government against such colleges?

(a) to (c) Medical Council of India has informed that it has received 15 complaints against private medical colleges. State-wise details of complaint, are as under:

Inspections have been carried out by Medical Council of India in respect of 13 colleges to verify these complaints. Wherever necessary, suitable action is initiated under the various provisions Indian Medical Council Act and the Rules made there under. However, in two case the matter is sub-judice.
