(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. The details of States affected by ground water quality problems due to contaminants such as Salinity, Fluoride, Chloride, Iron, Nitrate, etc. are given at Annexure-I.

(c)to(e): The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) with the help of other institutions had initiated a study for Metro cities. List of Metro cities for which Ground Water quality problems have been reported in the CPCB Study is enclosed at Annexure-II.

CPCB Study has suggested various measures for improvement in the quality of ground water. Key recommendations of the Study are listed at Annexure-III.
