- (c) whether the Government has received any proposal from the Government of Kerala for additional requirements to the RGAAT, Trivandrum; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) and (b):- Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has allotted two Hansa aircraft to Rajiv Gandhi Academy for Aviation Technology (RGAAT), Trivandrum during the year 2003-04. Also in July 2008 Aero Club of India (ACI) has allotted to this Academy one Cessna 172 R single engine aircraft procured out of the Grants in Aid received from the Government of India.
- (c) and (d):- No, Madam. However, ACI has received a request from RGAAT for allocation of one single engine simulator which would be considered by ACI on merits.
