(a), (b) & (c): No, Madam. However with the growth of Air Traffic in India, it has been felt to have a Central Air Traffic Flow Management System (ATFM) for smooth handling of increased traffic. Airports Authority of India (AAI) is in the process of establishing a Central ATFM in collaboration with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), USA.
