- (a) whether the Government has recently set up a Manpower Export Promotion Council to cater the growing demand for qualified and skilled workers; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF OVERSEAS INDIAN AFFAIRS (SHRI VAYALAR RAVI)

(a) & (b): No, Sir. However, the Government has established the Indian Council of Overseas Employment (ICOE) as a society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. The ICOE functions as a "think tank" for the Government on matters relating to international migration of Indian nationals for Overseas Employment and provides policy inputs with a view to devise and execute medium to long term strategies for promoting overseas employment of Indians.

The ICOE has a Governing Council to provide the broad policy framework to guide its programmes and activities. The Executive Directorate looks after the day to day management and implements its programmes and activities.
